Support for the resolution of the City of Kenora concerning the ban on flying lanterns in Ontario.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council approve the following resolution in support.

WHEREAS the use of flying/sky lanterns pose a significant risk of forest fire where used in rural areas;

AND WHEREAS policing this use will be extremely difficult for individual municipalities and Fire Departments;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does hereby support the City of Kenora in their petition to the province and requests that to ensure the safety of rural residents, their property and vast acreages of Crown property that the Provincial government makes the prudent decision to ban the use and sale of these lanterns, used primarily for entertainment, within the Province of Ontario.

BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The resolution of the City of Kenora is attached for information. These devices are lit and released often reaching significant heights and distances before coming to ground, not necessarily spent as a form of decoration and entertainment. I have personally witnessed their use in Head, Clara & Maria and had some concern with their ability to start fire.
