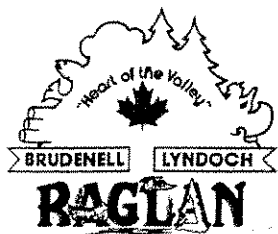

At a meeting held on Wednesday, January 9, 2013, the Township of Brudenell, Lyndoch and Raglan passed the attached resolution.

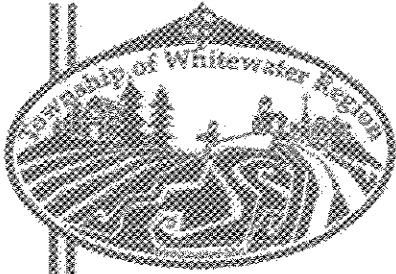
