With the coming holidays, the Municipal Office will be closed the following dates.

From Friday, December 21, 2018

to and including

Wednesday, January 2, 2019



Due to Statutory Holidays, Deux Rivieres and Bissett Creek waste collection will occur on Friday December 27th (instead of the 25th) and Wednesday January 2nd (instead of January 1st). Bissett Creek disposal site will be open after these collection times. Mackey and Stonecliffe waste collection and disposal site hours will be as normal.

The Garbage Collection between **December 24nd and January 6th** will be Amnesty Days where more than the usual one bag of garbage will be collected roadside. For these dates, two **untagged** bags of normal household waste will be allowed. Rules as to unacceptable materials and sorting of recyclables will be enforced. We are simply allowing an additional bag of regular household waste due to the “normal” amount of extras accumulated over the holidays.

Come January, the Disposal Site Hours will be Reduced once again - for January, February and March **ONLY** the disposal site hours will be as follows. Bissett - Tuesdays - 12:30 - 2:00 p.m. and Stonecliffe - Thursdays - 12:45 - 2:30 p.m. Saturday hours remain the same.

Winter Storms

Winter storms kill more Canadians than tornadoes, thunderstorms, lightning, floods and hurricanes combined.

Safety Tips

- Avoid unnecessary travel
- Wear layers of lightweight clothing, mittens and a hat
- Wear waterproof, insulated boots to keep your feet warm and dry and to keep from slipping on ice and snow
- Regularly check for frostbite — numbness or white areas on your face and body (ears, nose, cheeks, hands and feet in particular)
 - Avoid overexertion when shoveling snow by taking frequent breaks
 - Bring pets inside and move livestock to sheltered areas with non-frozen drinking water



Prepare Now

Take the following steps so you and your family are prepared in the event of an emergency:

- Winterize your home to retain heat:
 - insulate walls and attics;
 - caulk or weather-strip doors and windows;
 - install storm windows or cover windows with plastic
- Get heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected once a year
- Add extra blankets and warm clothes to your emergency survival kit
