

### Community Updates and Reminders

#### Municipal Tax Bills

Municipal tax bills will be issued in early July. The first installment is due on July 31st and the second installment is due on October 31st. There are several ways to pay your municipal tax bill including online baking (ScotiaBank only), over the phone with a credit card, or in the office by cheque, debit/credit or cash. We are pleased to announce that starting in July 2021, residents will also be able to send email money transfers to make payments. More details to follow.

#### Lending Hub

Due to COVID-19, the municipality has made the difficult decision to suspend the Lending Hub program for the 2021 season. We hope to bring back this service in 2022.

#### Policy Update

Council and staff continue in the process to update many municipal policies and by-laws. Two important policy by-laws that have been updated are the Roads Construction Minimum Standards Policy and the Level of Service for Roads Policy. The updates to these policies came after much consultation and input from municipal experts and stakeholders. Residents are encouraged to review these policies. They can be found on our website under the "Policies" tab or by contacting the office to request a paper copy.

#### Seasonal Dwellings

Residents are reminded that as per our Zoning By-Law, living year round in a seasonal dwelling is not permitted. Please contact the office if you are currently, or plan to, live year round in a seasonally zoned residence.

#### Bag Tags

This is a reminder that effective January 1st, 2021 bag tags are no longer required to be used for curbside pick up. The limit for pick up remains at 1 bag per household per week.

#### Council Meeting Schedule

A change has been made to the summer Council meeting schedule. There will now be a meeting held on Thursday, July 15th, 2021. This will take the place of the meeting that is normally held in August. There will be no regular August Council meeting. The annual Council meeting schedule can be found on our website.

#### **Burn Permits**

As per By-Law 2016-07, in Head, Clara & Maria a permit is required for all open air burning other than that for warmth or cooking, taking place during the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) fire season which runs from April 1 to October 31 annually. #### Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide (CO) Detectors

Residents are eligible to receive a new smoke alarm free of charge in exchange for one that is more than 5 years old. Carbon Monoxide detectors can be purchased for \$35.

#### **EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

The United Townships of Head, Clara and Maria is seeking applications for the following two positions:

#### Municipal Office Assistant - Casual Part-Time

Reporting to the Clerk-Treasurer, the Office Assistant will provide administrative assistance to the Clerk-Treasurer and Administrative and Finance Assistant as required, including but not limited to, reception services, word processing, photocopying, filing, research, collecting property tax and accounts receivable payments, maintaining statistics and other duties as assigned. The Office Assistant will also cover for administrative staff absences to ensure that the office is open on all designated days.

Pay scale for this position ranges from \$19.86 – \$24.55 per hour

#### **Municipal Summer Student**

The student must be between the ages of 15 and 30 and will assist the Public Works department with a variety of tasks including municipal park maintenance and clean up, painting, etc. Student will also assist Disposal Site Attendant with clean up and maintenance of municipal landfills.

This is a physically demanding job and will require working outside in the summer and the ability to operate basic municipal maintenance equipment (lawn mower, weed whacker). Other duties may be assigned as necessary such as assisting with administrative or recreational tasks if weather conditions prevent outside work.

Pay for this position is \$14.25 per hour
